HASLEMERE SWIMMING CLUB – B GRADE LEVEL 3 MEET

A group of the youngest swimmers from Amersham Swimming Club, mainly from the Tadpoles Squads, gained valuable experience of competition at the Haslemere B Grade Level 3 Meet on 20th April.

The swimmers, including many 9 and 10 year olds taking part in their first gala, participated in 95 races and achieved 74 new personal best times. They picked up several silver and bronze medals and a number of ribbons for top 8 placings.

Hugo Bellamy (9 yrs) took bronze in the 200m freestyle (3:16.37), bronze in the 50m breaststroke (53.46) and was eighth in the 50m backstroke (49.87).

Cameron Winchcombe (9 yrs) took bronze in the 50m backstroke (47.67) and fourth in the 200m freestyle (3:18.88).

Felicity Kersting (9 yrs) took silver in the 50m backstroke (46.70) and bronze in the 50m freestyle (40.22).

Eleanor Job (9 yrs) took silver in the 50m breaststroke (53.22).

Holly Fisher (10 yrs) was fourth in the 50m breaststroke (48.77) and seventh in the 100m IM (1:37.79).

Molly Simons (11 yrs) was sixth in the 100m IM (1:30.58), 8th in the 50m 'fly (43.30) and 8th in the 50m freestyle (36.05).

Ross Calder (9 yrs) was seventh in the 50m breaststroke (54.98).

Gemma Saunders (9 yrs) was fifth in the 100m IM (1:46.24).

Tom Lawrence (10 yrs) was sixth in the 50m breaststroke (52.81).

Sabine Bellamy (11 yrs) was fourth in the 50m freestyle (35.28) and seventh in the 200m freestyle (2:54.19).

Molly Norman (10 yrs) was ninth in both the 200m freestyle (3:00.12) and 50m backstroke (44.23).

Keelyn Lowe (11 yrs) took bronze in the 50m freestyle (35.30), was fifth in both the 200m freestyle (2:56.47) and 50m backstroke (42.04), and ninth in the 100m IM (1:31.79).
