

AMERSHAM SWIMMING CLUB

NEWBURY DISTRICT SWIMMING CLUB – OPEN MEET

21st JUNE 2008

12 Clubs from around the South East were represented at the Newbury District Swimming Club Open Meet on 21st June, including 20 swimmers from Amersham Swimming Club.

Swimmers were required to enter 'not faster than' times for their events, and any swimmers exceeding the fastest time received a speeding ticket. The first three swimmers in every event received medals and swimmers placed 4th 5th and 6th received certificates.

The Amersham team picked up one speeding ticket, together with 5 gold, 8 silver and 4 bronze medals, and broke 4 meet records.

Becky O'Brien was presented with the Top Girl award and Tom Strudwick was placed third for the boys. Amersham finished in third position overall.

Becky O'Brien (19 yrs) took gold in the 100m backstroke (1:13.23); gold in the 100m freestyle (1:04.24) for a meet record; gold in the 200m IM (2:35.79) setting a further meet record; fourth in the 100m 'fly (1:15.41) and fourth in the 100m breaststroke (1:25.38).

Andrew Beveridge (14 yrs) won a speeding ticket in the 100m freestyle (1:00.16); silver in the 100m backstroke (1:08.74) and fourth in the 100m 'fly (1:14.64).

Katrina Beveridge (13 yrs) took silver in the 100m backstroke (1:14.21)

Marcus Hazelwood (13 yrs) took silver in the 100m breaststroke (1:24.74).

Daniel Barraclough (13 yrs) took bronze in the 100m freestyle (1:02.08).

Max Elphick (12 yrs) won silver in the 100m 'fly (1:25.29); bronze in the 100m backstroke (1:18.78); fourth in the 200m IM (2:57.61) and sixth in the 100m breaststroke.

Matt Hazelwood (12 yrs) won bronze in the 100m breaststroke (1:30.73) and was fifth in the 200m IM (2:57.93).

Millie Price (12 yrs) won gold in the 100m breaststroke (1:27.95) for a meet record; silver in the 100m freestyle (1:10.49); fourth in the 100m backstroke (1:21.18) and fourth in the 200m IM (2:56.21).

Max Poplawski (12 yrs) was sixth in the 100m backstroke (1:21.98).

Tom Harrison (11 yrs) won bronze in the 200m IM (2:57.24).

Tom Strudwick (9 yrs) won gold in the 100m IM (1:29.99) for a meet record; silver in the 50m breaststroke (47.90); silver in the 50m freestyle (34.56); and silver in the 50m backstroke (40.80).

Hugo Bellamy (9 yrs) was sixth in the 50m freestyle (38.19) and sixth in the 50m backstroke (45.25).
