

AMERSHAM SWIMMING CLUB

NEWBURY DISTRICT SWIMMING CLUB – OPEN MEET

20th June 2009

Eight clubs from Bucks and Berks were represented at the Newbury District Swimming Club Open Meet on 20th June, including 15 swimmers from Amersham Swimming Club.

Swimmers were required to enter 'not faster than' times for their events and any swimmers exceeding the fastest time received a speeding ticket. The first three swimmers in every event received medals and swimmers placed 4th 5th and 6th received certificates.

The Amersham team picked up 8 silver medals and 4 bronze medals and achieved many personal best times.

Andrew Beveridge (15) was placed fourth overall for the boys.

Amersham finished in fifth position overall, after Newbury, Wycombe, Tilehurst and Reading.

Andrew Beveridge (15 yrs) won a silver medal in the 100m breaststroke (1:20.18); silver in the 100m backstroke (1:04.70); bronze in the 200m IM (2:30.25); fourth in the 100m freestyle (59.09) and fifth in the 100m 'fly (1:07.58).

Marcus Hazelwood (14 yrs) took silver in the 200m IM (2:29.57); bronze in the 100m backstroke (1:12.76); fourth in the 100m 'fly (1:11.83) and seventh in the 100m freestyle (1:05.54).

Matt Hazelwood (13 yrs) won silver in the 100m breaststroke (1:24.17) and was sixth in the 100m 'fly (1:17.04).

Max Elphick (13 yrs) was sixth in the 100m backstroke (1:16.02); eighth in the 100m 'fly (1:19.53); and ninth in the 100m breaststroke (1:31.65).

Max Poplawski (13 yrs) was fifth in the 100m backstroke (1:15.77); seventh in the 100m 'fly (1:17.71) and eighth in 100m freestyle (1:04.79).

Drew Tate (13 yrs) was eighth in the 100m breaststroke (1:30.30).

George Simmons (10 yrs) was fifth in the 50m breaststroke (51.56) and seventh in the 100m IM (1:35.20).

Poppy Casterton (10 yrs) won a silver medal in the 50m 'fly (42.14); bronze in the 100m IM (1:32.93); bronze in the 50m freestyle (34.97) and was seventh in the 50m backstroke (43.68).

Brogan Davies (10 yrs) was fifth in the 100m IM (1:37.11) and seventh in the 50m breaststroke (49.59).

Danielle Parker (10 yrs) was fifth in the 50m 'fly (44.14) and ninth in the 100m IM (1:40.26).

Molly Simmons (12 yrs) won 2 silver medals in the 100m breaststroke (1:33.40) and 100m freestyle (1:10.76). She was fourth in the 200m IM (2:56.94) and fourth in the 100m backstroke (1:20.69).

Amber Veronique (12 yrs) was ninth in the 100m backstroke (1:22.75).

Bryony Ceurvorst (12 yrs) was ninth in the 100m 'fly (1:35.42).

Katrina Beveridge (14 yrs) took silver in the 100m backstroke (1:13.02); seventh in the 200m IM (2:47.39) and ninth in the 100m 'fly.

Pippa McCullough (14 yrs) was fourth in the 100m freestyle (1:05.98); sixth in the 200m IM (2:47.35); seventh in the 100m 'fly (1:21.92) and seventh in the 100m backstroke (1:17.66).
